



County Commission to Consider Resolution

Commissioners Hansen and Moreno presenting resolution in support of Global Climate Strike

SANTA FE, NM – County Commissioners Anna Hansen (D-2) and Ed Moreno (D-5) will present a joint resolution at the next Santa Fe County Board of County Commission meeting on Tuesday, September 10, 2019, in support of the Global Climate Strike, being organized for Friday, September 20, 2019, by the New Mexico Youth United for Climate Crisis Action (YUCCA).

The New Mexico rally will take place at the Roundhouse from 11:30 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. and will consist of thousands of youth and adult allies from across the state demanding immediate action on climate change. Specifically, the group is demanding that the Governor declare a climate emergency, create a Just Transition fund and invest in the planning necessary for our state

to reach carbon neutrality by 2030 with support for on the ground planning and transition process for local communities, and to champion community solar legislation.

“I am excited, as an elected official, to bring forward this important resolution which recognizes that we are all aware of the devastating impact that climate disruption is having on not only our community, but around the world,” says Commissioner Hansen. “Your presence in the Board of County Commissioners’ Chambers when passing this resolution is another statement of your support for this global action on climate emergency.”

The worldwide climate strike is being organized by dozens of international, national, and local groups; large gatherings are expected in major cities including New York, London, and Berlin, with strikes taking place across Africa, Latin America, and Asia as well.

The Santa Fe County Board of County Commission has passed a number of resolutions that support the climate including Resolutions 2017-68, 2018-124, and 2019-41.


